DECISION SIGNAL

Jordan's official monthly CPI year-on-year rate rose from 1.06% in January to 2.79% in June, peaking at 2.83% in May. Monthly price growth remained positive but slowed to 0.14% in June.

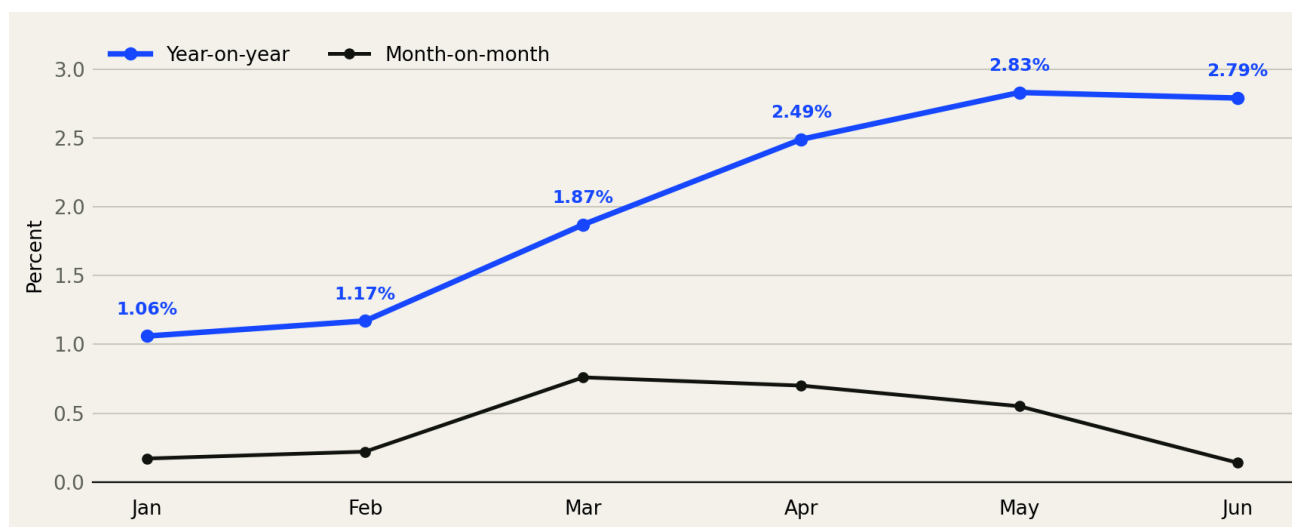

Six releases. One bounded observation.

Every number below is tied to an official monthly release. The Lab does not substitute a first-half average for a monthly year-on-year rate and does not infer causality from the six-point pattern.

WHAT THE EVIDENCE SUPPORTS

OBSERVED ACCELERATION	The monthly year-on-year rate increased for four consecutive releases from January through May, then eased by 0.04 percentage points in June.
POSITIVE MONTHLY MOVEMENT	Month-on-month rates were positive in all six recorded releases; the June rate was the lowest since January.
NO CAUSAL ATTRIBUTION	The release-level fields do not isolate the contribution of taxes, administered prices, supply conditions, exchange rates, housing, or food categories.

Readable enough to use. Specific enough to challenge.

UNIT OF OBSERVATION

Country × reference month × published measure. This brief uses Jordan's national headline monthly year-on-year and month-on-month CPI rates.

EVIDENCE CUTOFF

13 August 2026. Later revisions are outside this version and should trigger a new release note.

TRANSFORMATION

Direct transcription into the Observatory's processed panel; percentage-point changes are arithmetic differences between published rates.

STATUS

The source-bound values are part of v0.3.0-rc1. Independent reproduction and source-file hashing remain pending.

LIMITATIONS

- Six releases are a short descriptive window; they do not establish a durable trend or forecast.
- Headline CPI is not a direct measure of household welfare, purchasing power, poverty, or cost pressure for any specific population group.
- The brief does not compare Jordan with other countries because release definitions, coverage and structural conditions can differ.
- The Lab links to official source pages but has not yet frozen publisher files with cryptographic hashes; upstream pages may change.
- This sample has not been independently reproduced. It must not be described as an audited output.
